

#### **EDITORIAL** -

The commercial casino industry has seen significant growth over the last few decades. Thanks to the ongoing legalization of gamblingrelated activities and the growth of the experience economy in many parts of the world, licensed casinos have expanded to new markets and generated record-breaking revenue figures.

That being said, the brick-and-mortar casino industry has faced significant challenges with the rise of online gambling and the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, which caused many casinos to close their doors to the public.

However, this industry is still expected to see growth, for example, the total revenue of casinos in the U.S. was forecast to increase year over year from 2021 to 2024.

In the United Arab Emirates, it was reported in January of this year that hotel and casino operator Wynn Resorts plans to build a luxury resort in Ras Al Khaimah with a "gaming area", potentially paving the way for gambling to be allowed in the Muslim Gulf state.

In a sign that entertainment rules might be loosened, the Ras Al Khaimah Tourism Development Authority created a new Department of Entertainment and Gaming Regulation to regulate "integrated resorts".
