### **EDITORIAL** -

The infrastructure sector, in particular aviation, took a real hit during the pandemic. It was estimated that commercial flight activity decreased by between 50 - 60 percent in 2020 alone. The unfortunate knock on effect to the construction sector was that many existing projects were put on hold or cancelled.

The issue that's always been evident in aviation projects is the forecasting of future demand and long development lead time and beginning planning projects well ahead of schedule.

Abu Dhabi Airport saw passenger numbers triple in 2022 as the world emerged from the Pandemic heralding long awaited news that the new Midfield Terminal would open sometime in 2023. Will the rising demand outpace the development of new and extension projects to cater for this?

WT provided pre-contract Cost Planning and tender document support for the recently opened expansion of Hamad International Airport's Concourse D&E. Planning and the opening of this project coincided with the FIFA World Cup held November & December last year.
